Policy-relevant research and analysis, Modelling, data and statistics

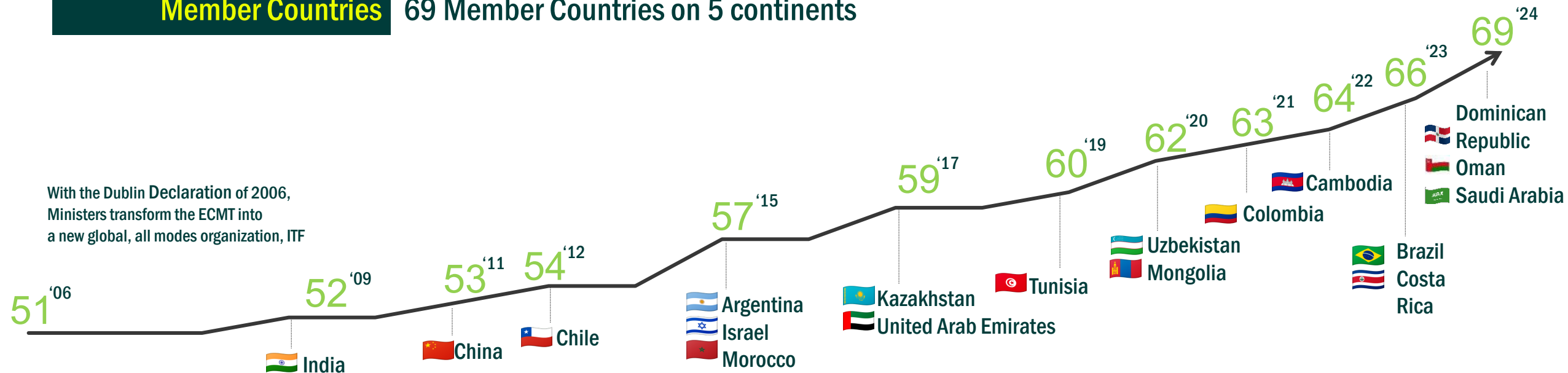
The Summit

Outline

- Road freight transport licenses allowing mutual access to the markets of 43 European Member Countries of the ITF
- Introduced on 1 January 1974 by the ECMT Council of Ministers

Aims

- Gradual liberalisation of road freight transport
- Rationalisation of the use of vehicles, reducing empty running
- Incentive for use of environmentally friendly and safe vehicles
- Harmonisation of the terms of competition
 - Quality Charter introduced by European Ministers in 2016

Digitalisation of ECMT Quota allowing comprehensive management and enforcement of ECMT licenses (planned for 1 January 2025)

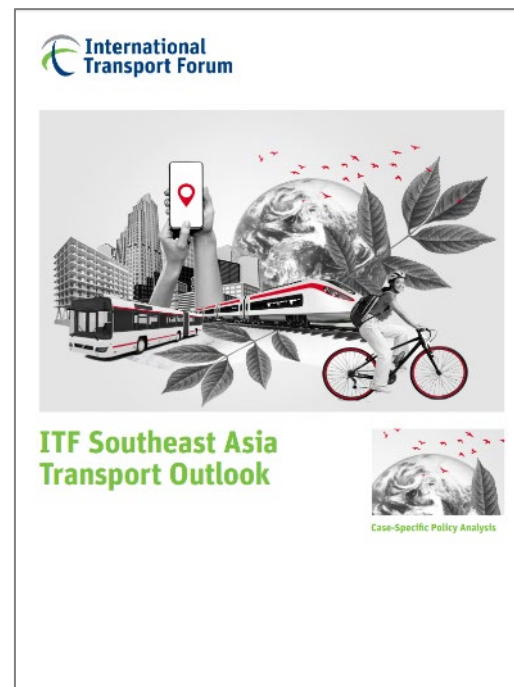
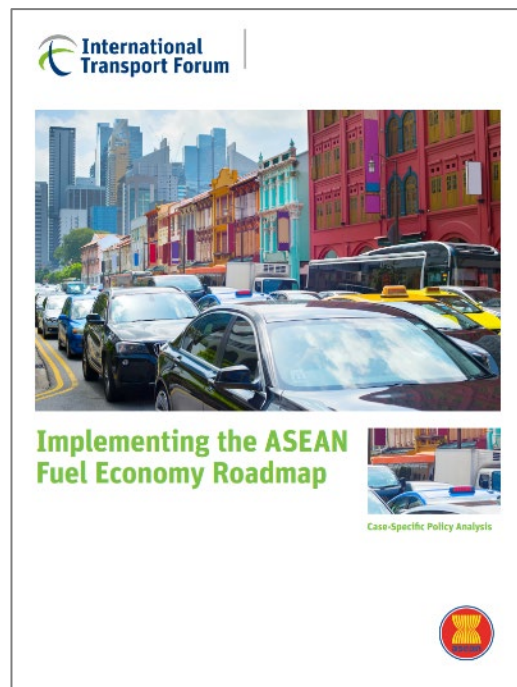


ITF Work on Gender
