1. COUNTRY PROFILE








2. ROADTRANSPORT

A. Road Infrastructure



• In 2023, the total road length is 67,935Km with 15,681Km of paved road.

2. ROAD TRANSPORT (CONT.)

Expressway

- The new Phnom Penh–Sihanoukville Expressway
 has been completed and is in operation from
 October 2022 with the total length of 187,05 KM.
- Moreover, RGC planned to construct more expressways in the country.
 - ✓ The Phnom Penh-Bavet Expressway has already begun construction on June 2023 with total length of 135,10Km (Plan to complete in 2027)
 - ✓ The Phnom Penh-Siem Reap-Poipet Expressway project is in the pipeline and will expect to be built in the near future.


Phnom Penh-Sihanoukville Expressway

2. ROAD TRANSPORT (CONT.)





- Number of new vehicle registration increased annually
- In 2023, 370 thousand vehicles are registered, which are decrease of -33% compared to 2022 (555 thousand)

C. Road traffic accidents



 KPI on road safety (#30) Number of traffic accident casualties (dead) for 2023 is 756 (converted: Road Traffic fatality per 100,000 population is 5 people)



3. RAILWAY TRANSPORT

A. Railway Transport Infrastructure

- · Cambodia has two railway lines :
 - the Northern Line was constructed in late 1920s
 - the Southern Line was constructed in the 1960s
 - In total, the two railway lines have a total length of 652 km (width 1000 mm).
- Some railway projects have been planned in the CITLS-MP 2023-2033.








3. RAILWAY TRANSPORT (CONT.)

B. Railway Passengers



- Passenger service suspended for some time but since 2016, passenger train service re-started
- There is a dramatic increase in railway passengers in 2023 to 125,409 passengers compared to 69,344 passengers in 2022.








3. RAILWAY TRANSPORT (CONT.)

C. Railway Freight



Freight volume increased rapidly since 2016 to 2020. The total freight volumes in 2023 increased 18% (1,079,281 ton) compared to 2022 (911,445 ton)



4. WATERWAY TRANSPORT

A. Sihanoukville Autonomous Port (PAS)

- ➤ an international gateway, playing a vital role for facilitating trade and business activities for Cambodia
- ➤ only deep-sea port of Cambodia with the areas of 125 hectares and situated along the Cambodian coastline in Sihanoukville
- ➤ with the capacity of approximately 750,000 TEUs/year





B. Phnom Penh Autonomous Port (PPAP)

- is the 2nd largest port in Cambodia
- In 2013, PPAP expanded the container operation to Container Terminal LM17
- annual storage capacity: 400,000 TEUs









5. AIR TRANSPORT

- International airports:
 - ➤ Phnom Penh International Airport,
 - ➤ Sihanoukville International Airport,
 - ➤ Siem Reap-Angkor International Airport,
 - ➤ Dara Sakor International Airport, (operated for Domestic flight in December, 2024)
 - Techo International Airport (4F, Kandal Province), which will be completed in March 2025 and will be operated in July 2025


